### **PROPERTY NEWS**

- During the summer holiday break the administration area and the corridor adjacent to Rooms 1,2 and 3 will be modernised. This is a joint project with the Catholic Diocese of Auckland.
- The BOT approved funding for additional shading around the school this will see replacement sails being installed above the sandpit and over the concrete tennis table area as well as a new shade structure over the Junior Playground.


### **SECOND HAND UNIFORM**
