Winter Uniform

We have definitely noticed a drop in temperature particularly in the early morning and late evening. Winter uniform items can now be worn. By Monday 13th May, winter uniform should be worn by all students - no summer dresses or sandals from this date please.

School Drop Off

There is no supervision on-site until 8.30am, however a member of the leadership team is usually out front from 8.25am. Please note: school officially starts at 8.50am. Dropping your child between 8.30 and 8.45am allows plenty of time to prepare for the day ahead. If you require early morning supervision, SKIDS is available.

Safety and Wellbeing

Your child's wellbeing, happiness and safety at school is always our number one priority. No school is perfect and from time to time your child may talk to you about not feeling happy or safe at school. We operate a zero-tolerance to bullying policy at St Mark's and pride ourselves on responding swiftly to any claims of harassment or mean behaviour. We help our students understand the difference between bullying (intentional, persistent and targeted negative acts to harm others) and mean, or insensitive behaviour (often reactionary and one-off). We ensure restorative practices are in place so those impacted can acknowledge any wrong-doing or conflict and work together to restore harmony. If you have any concerns whatsoever, please contact your child's teacher in the first instance.
